

Case Study Network & Security Engineering

Contract Description:

A banking, financial, insurance industry customer required network security engineering assessment existing capability and proposals and deployments of new capabilities to address multiple areas of network security concern. A level of effort was required to improve security, reduce overall attack surface, and provide security related visibility into network systems and services. Work would be done remotely as well as onsite at the customers location in Kansas City, MO.
